The 2019 Legislative Session will begin January 8, 2019 and legislators are sure to be taking hard looks at many important issues. Sunset Review of the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy (TSBPA) and the Texas Public Accountancy Act (TPAA) is the number one issue for TSCPA during the 2019 Texas Legislative Session. Our top priority will be to assure a successful completion of the Sunset Review process and the reauthorization of TSBPA and the TPAA so the licensed profession in Texas will continue unabated.

Because we cannot leave these decisions to uninformed or unfriendly legislators, the TSCPA CPA-PAC prepared this Texas Guide to 2018 State Elections to provide you with helpful information to make your voting decisions on November 6, 2018, or during the early voting period, which begins on October 22, 2018.



Candidates for Statewide and Legislative Races

Although the TSCPA CPA-PAC did not make any statewide or legislative candidate endorsements for this election cycle, it does support candidates who are generally open to TSCPA's issues and suggestions and are accessible to TSCPA members and representatives.

The following is a list of Democratic and Republican candidates for statewide offices, as well as Senate and House district seats in the Texas Legislature. Legislative races are listed by chapter area for easier reading. Some Senate and House districts overlap chapter areas and are listed in each applicable chapter. You can determine which races will be on your precinct ballot by obtaining state Senate and House district numbers found on your voter registration card. Names in all caps are incumbents and names marked with a dollar sign received support from TSCPA CPA-PAC and chapter PAC funds.
